PAID POLICE PATROL



Our paid police patrols kicked off in early March. To date, we have raised a little over \$40,000. We still need about 20 homes to pay in to fully fund one 4-hour patrol, five days per week. Even more will get us to 6 days per week.

The officers have already helped with several incidents, including somebody wandering on

Rosser who was taken into custody and admitted to the Parkland psychiatric ward.

Paying members receive the ENP cell phone number, and can call the officers to report suspicious things, and also have them watch their homes while out of town.
