

Walnut Hill Volunteers In Patrol Monthly Meeting
April 28, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Bob Noyes at 7:07 pm.

Present were: Bob Noyes, Linda and Art Befort, Phil Hughes, Bill Marx, Paul Figel, Chuck Pomatto, Mike and Margaret Conlin, Jean Ryan, and Ilda Manriquez. Guests were Officer Burnside of the DPD and Rodney Patterson of Dallas City Code Enforcement.

Officer Burnside reported that there were the same amount of non-violent crimes reported in March of 2010 as in March of 2009 —10 incidences. Five of the crimes were burglary of a motor vehicle. (2 cars parked on the streets of Duchess Trail and Crestover, 1 car parked in driveway of residence on Best, and 2 cars in parking lots of grocery store on Marsh. One of the cars was unlocked. GPS and visible cell phones are the most vulnerable and easiest to take.) A vacant house on 3700 block of Royal Cove was broken into and property taken as well as houses on the 10,000 block of Midway and 4000 block of Killion. A trailer was taken from the driveway of a residence on the 1000 block of Coppedge and a lap top computer was taken from a student at the Episcopal School of Dallas on Merrell. No violent crimes were reported.

Linda reported that the crime watch treasury balance is \$6,150.70 after paying PayPal expense \$3.60 for the website dues paying shopping cart and deposits of \$545.00. We have a total of 109 paid Crime Watch members or \$545.00, 111 paid Homeowner's members or \$610.00, and 112 ENP members. ENP total is \$14,010.00 since the letter went out last month reminding people to renew or subscribe to the program.

Chuck reported that the number of patrols has increased in the first quarter of this year. He wished to thank the following members for their time and dedication in patrolling: Bob Turney, Paul Figel, Randy Griffin, Martha Templeton, Cheryl Templeton, Margaret and Mike Conlin, Bob and Monica Noyes, Phil Hughes, Joyce Tepley, Barbara Stone, Joe and Maryann Mathews, Gay Boyer, and Bill Marx.

Paul was authorized by the members present to buy new magnetic car signs with the Dallas Police Volunteer logo on them.

Bob announced that elections for VIP officers are next month. He has agreed to be Homeowner's Chairman so will be needing help with the Fourth of July Parade and picnic.
